


India is the leading global milk producer



330 million India is home to more than 300 million bovine females.




24% India contributed 24% of global milk production in 2021-22.





#### More than four-in-ten people in India are under 25 years old


Number and share of people in India, by age





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


### Global growth of dairy will come from India


### India's cooperative structure











### High tariffs and protectionism


- Published duties range between 30% to 60%
- However bound duties range between 40% and 150% and India is resistant to large dairy imports
- Europe, US and NZ are all striving for a FTA including dairy
- Imports volumes have remained quite small and inconsistent for commodities like milk powders and milkfat/ butter
- Less so with products like whey which are not available
- Imports are allowed to increase only when there is domestic shortage.


