




Milk Cows and Milk per Cow










Summary

- U.S. dairy exports are competing and growing globally
- Dairy prices are returning to normal after two years of pandemic related volatility
- U.S. consumers are drinking less milk but eating more dairy
- Disruptions from COVID-19 saw record meat prices
- But consolidation in the meat packing industry prevented U.S. farmers from realizing high meat prices and farm-gate prices remained low
- This has led to the lowest U.S. cattle herd in 73-years
- Sexed semen is reducing the total dairy herd size
- A smaller herd means higher replacement prices
- The United States has less farms but the same number of milk cows
- Farmers continue to grow productivity and produce more milk with the same number of animals

The U.S. dairy sector remains vibrant, complicated, and continues to show dynamism despite headwinds and challenges. U.S. farmers are showing up, solving problems, and ready to supply high-quality products not only at home but to the world.


